In this forum, various issues were discussed, from resident training to the organization of the health care system. The scientific program of the congress covered four main topics: pelvic floor rehabilitation, vestibular rehabilitation, aging and sarcopenia, and functional movement disorders. The last part of the event was post-congress musculoskeletal ultrasound and vestibular rehabilitation workshops. We are pleased to state that the congress had a positive financial balance.

COMMISSION FOR EDUCATION, TRAINING AND FURTHER EDUCATION IN THE PRM

- Together the delegates of the DGPRM (German PRM Society) and BVPRM (professional PRM association), the commission forms the joint AG WBO (Working group PRM training regulations, Speaker: Max Liebl). National Competency-Based Catalog of Learning Objectives Medicine (NKLM): A speciality assignment process of learning objectives of the NKLM to the likely planned speciality areas according to future licensing regulations was completed under the direction of the AWMF (working group of scientific medical societies). In the

process, numerous learning objectives that are particularly relevant to the speciality of PRM were assigned to the speciality of PRM. The NKLM can be viewed online at https://nklm. de including the speciality assignments.

GERMAN ACADEMY FOR PRM (DAPRM)

- At the end of 2021, the German Academy for Physical and Rehabilitative Medicine (DAPRM) was founded, formally as a DGPRM commission, with the aim of offering advanced training courses for (prospective) PRM specialists. The tasks of the ARGE PRM. which has since been dissolved, were also transferred to the Academy. Christina Lemhöfer (representative: Christian Sturm) took over the management of the DAPRM. An advisory board, which supports the management in terms of content, is staffed together with the professional association. In addition to the "specialist courses", courses for obtaining the additional qualification and offers for other professional groups are to be developed in the coming years. In May 2022, the first specialist PRM refresher course took place in Hannover with great success and was repeated in November 2022 as an online version. This concept is now to be offered twice a year (2023 again in May and November). Further offers for this year and next are or are currently being developed (e.g. Introductory course - therapy with botulinum toxin in November 2022ff). The courses are advertised on the homepage of the DGPRM (sub-point Academy) as well as via the magazine and the Young Forum PRM.

Short report (up to 200 words) on national PRM congress (if organized from September 2022):

The Yearly Congress of the Hungarian Rehabilitation Society in 2022 was organized between 29 September and 1 October 2022, in Siófok, Hungary. The number of participants was 420. The main topics involved the situation of rehabilitation during the COVID pandemic, rehabilitation post stroke, innovative technologies, children's rehabilitation, amputees, osteoporosis, osteoarthritis, speech therapy, neuropsychology.

The Yearly Congress of the Hungarian Rehabilitation Society, including the General Assembly where the leaders of the Society will be elected for the next years is due between 12-14 October 2023, in Siófok, Hungary. The main topics involve transition young people with disabilities from the children to the adult rehabilitation setting, neurorehabilitation, chronic pain, use of artificial intelligence and telemedicine in rehabilitation, robotics in rehabilitation, speech diagnostics and therapy, neuropsychology, other topics. Around 400-450 participants are expected. Number of presentations will be 150 plus sponsored lectures, two teaching courses (how to build into a rehabilitation programme the devices based on advanced technology and the other will be about using MRI in rehabilitation). There will a workshop in music therapy.

A 3-year weak academic program for PRM residents from all departments of the country is organized (mostly virtual) by PRM division of Tel Aviv University (TAU).

All PRM departments are teaching medical students from their regional universities. In most places, the course is one week long and is voluntary. The TAU is an exception – obligatory 2-week round for all students. Nowadays the Council together with the Ministry of Health Rehabilitation Director is making efforts to change PRM rounds to obligatory in all universities.

Short report on national PRM congress.

The annual national congress of the Israel Association of Physical and Rehabilitation Medicine was held 6-7 December 2022 in Avenue Convention Center near Ben-Gurion Airport. It was a 72nd congress, named RSTU-2022 (Rehabilitation Science & Technology Update). As always, we had 2 - full days of scientific activity, created of scientific and didactic sessions in different fields of PRM in 4 sections. Opening lectures were given by Prof. Steven Kirshblum from SCI Research New Jersey System, United States: "SCI Research and Rehabilitation: Past, Present and Future"; and Prof. Leon Deouell from ELSC Edmond & Lily Safra Center, Israel: "The interface between conscious and non-conscious perception, roles of attention and spatial representation in conscious awareness".

The closing plenary invited lecture was given by Dr. Nachum Soroker after obtaining the Haim Ring Lifetime Achievement Award in PRM activity in Israel and abroad: "Thoughts about empiric and theoretical rehabilitation treatments for hemiparesis, neglect and aphasia".

There were around 600 participants from all rehabilitation professional fields, and 30 supporting and exhibiting companies at the congress.

Before the Congress – Rehabilitation week with professional hands-on workshops, was organized in different PRM departments of Israel. This year 5 such workshops were prepared from dissimilar PRM fields.



REPORT ON THE ITALIAN SOCIETY OF PHYSICAL AND REHABILITATION MEDICINE (SIMFER)

SIMFER (Italian Society of Physical and Rehabilitation Medicine) is the Italian leading specialist medical society for Physiatry. Members of SIMFER are PRM specialists, trainees and other medical doctors working in the field of rehabilitation. It was established in 1958.

The main purposes of SIMFER are to promote high standards in the practice of physiatry, through education, science, and ethics, to support the role of PRM in the healthcare systems and to advocate for the participation and inclusion of the persons with disability.

Regional Groups and Special Interest Scientific Committees contribute to the activities of the Society.

SIMFER organizes an annual national Congress; it publishes the bimonthly the "Europen Journal of Physical and rehabilitation Medicine" (which is also the official journal of the European Society of Physical and Rehabilitation Medicine), and the quarterly "Giornale Italiano di Medicina Riabilitativa" (Italian Journal of Rehabilitation Medicine).

Over the last year (Sept 22-Sept 23) we organised a PRM symposium to enhance the specialty in Malta together with an educational meeting on Spasticity Management.

The PRM conference this year took the form of a day symposium where we invited various stakeholders related to PRM (doctors and allied health staff) to participate and present their views on the current situation of PRM in Malta and future prospectives in the field.

11 Congress of the Polish Rehabilitation Society took place between 13-14 May 2022 in Cracow.

22 Symposium of the Polish Rehabilitation Society is scheduled between 7-9 December 2023 in Pabianice.

A short report of crucial Problems of PRM in Poland.

PRM in Poland has been recognized as a basic medical specialty since 1958. Since then comprehensive rehabilitation with multidisciplinary teamwork coordinated by PRM physicians has been practised. Political changes in Poland in the 1980s-1990s. resulted among others in the division of the Ministry of Health and

Social Welfare into two independent resorts. This fact resulted in increasing difficulties in practicing medical/social coordinated care. Other problems facing PRM practice include:

- claims of representatives of rehabilitation team professionals (mainly PTs) who insist on equaling "rehabilitation" with physiotherapy by denying other than physical patients' needs, and pursue to eliminate PRM physicians (specialists) from the healthcare system.
- inadequate reimbursement of PRM procedures, undervaluation of outpatient rehabilitation, lack of reimbursement of typical PRM procedures (such as interventional ultrasonography), inpatient PRM services.

Recent number of PRM specialists in Poland: 2020.

Recent number of PRM trainees in Poland: 233.

Overall number of young physicians in Poland is inadequate which affects the training of young specialists in almost all medical specialties. Particularly the number of young physicians taking up PRM training is insufficient. It results in a decreasing number of young PRM physicians and a rising mean age of PRM specialists.

The following actions and strategies are undertaken/planned:

- 1. Lobbying/propagation/educational actions to improve awareness of publicity/stakeholders/politicians/patients/medical professionals/persons responsible for decisions in a healthcare organization of the importance and unique role of PRM in the healthcare system and competencies of PRM physicians. Other aim is to obtain a status of a "deficit specialty" for PRM, that would result in preferred financing for trainees:
- interactions with politicians, medical professionals, DPOs;
- lobbying activities of the President of the Polish rehabilitation Society (serving also as a Counselor of the Senior Policy Committee of the Polish Parliament) National Consultant of PRM, representatives of the Polish Rehabilitation Society;
- organization of conferences, courses, public campaigns, providing lectures, publication of informative materials. Of interest there are

conferences for trainers and teachers on how to teach rehabilitation (fist such conference was held on 16.06.2023), Nest will be a conference for final year medical students propagating PRM role(planned for March-April 2024). All those events have free registration;

- 2. Modification of the undergraduate education impress medical students and untrained physicians with knowledge of how PRM is attractive and demanded, by:
- Increasing the number of teaching hours of PRM and ensuring the provision of updated and practical content (according to the undergraduate curriculum by the European Board of PRM) with the assurance of optimal practical training;
- implementation of ETRs.

3. Improvement in postgraduate PRM training:

- shortcutting of PRM specialty for interested physicians representing other specialties (internal medicine, paediatrics, pediatric surgery, orthopaedics & traumatology, neurology, and occupational medicine;
- emphasizing practical skills of PRM physicians in the training process by organizing more courses in applications of ultrasound for diagnostics and interventions, practical skills in spasticity management, comprehensive pain management, etc.
- implementation of ETRs

4. Implementation of ICF-based assessment in PRM to visualize its efficacy and assure the need for an effective rehabilitation team.

The 8th Congress of the Slovenian Society for P&R Medicine was organized from 17th - 19th November 2022 in Primus Grand Hotel in the city of Ptuj. The participation of 120 satisfied attendees from Slovenia and Croatia was above expected number. The sessions of the scientific programme were: Rehabilitation after vascular diseases and amputations (Chairs H. Burger and N. Kos), Rehabilitation of persons with CNS lesions and injuries (Chairs T. Hernja-Rumpf and N. Bizovičar), Rehabilitation in children (Chairs K. Groleger-Sršen and T. Kovačec-Hermann), Rehabilitation of persons with acute and long term sequelae of Covid-19 (Chairs P. Novak and B. Jesenšek-Papež), Rehabilitation of patients with inflamatory and degenerative MSK disorders (Chairs K. Grabljevec, T. Rauter-Pungartnik) and Rehabilitation after MSK trauma and sport injuries (Chairs: K. Cunder and M. Zorko).

The special plenary session on Chronic pain in adults and children/adolescents was held by Z. Kuret and M. Stahl.

Pre-congress workshops for residents were organized on the topics: Indications and contraindications for the advanced methods in physical therapy (A. Poljićanin and B. Bećir), Neuromodulation in spasticity and chronic pain – rehabilitation approach (K. Grabljevec and Z. Kuret) and How to write a scientific article (K. Groleger-Sršen).

INTRODUCTION AND ORGANIZATION

The Spanish Society of Physical & Rehabilitation Medicine (SERMEF) was founded in 1957 and currently has about 1,200 full members plus a few more associate and honorary members.

The current address of its headquarters is in Madrid on Rodríguez Marín street.

Its current president is Dr. Carolina de Miguel-Benadiba, a PRM-specialist physician who works at the Ramón y Cajal Hospital in Madrid.

SERMEF principles are:

- To promote the development of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, both in practice and in teaching
- 2. The publication of a scientific research journal of our members
- 3. The cooperation with other scientific societies and organizations in the research and development of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation
- 4. To provide information and advice, when necessary, to the different government bodies, autonomic bodies and local and provincial organizations

The Society is present at: The National Commission of the Specialty of Physical and Rehabilitation Med., professional environments such as the Federation of Spanish Medical Scientific Associations and The Spanish Collegiate Medical Organization.

There are some SERMEF affiliated societies even at regional and scientific/monographic level, as well as several working groups

At regional level, there are 14 societies, each one of them, autonomous in its operation and that organizes its own events, publications, courses, working groups, etc. On the other hand, at monographic and scientific level there are The Spanish Society of: Paraplegia (SEP), Acquired brain injury (SERDACE), Children rehab (SERI), Orthopedic and Manual Medicine (SEMOOYM, Cardio-respiratory rehab (SORECAR), Phoniatrics

rehab (SOREFON), Geriatric rehab (SERG) and Labor rehab.

Regarding National Working Groups, we can mention: Shock Waves, Lymphedema, Osteoporosis rehab, Pelvic Floor, Interventional rehab, Biomechanics, Vestibular Rehab, Private medicine, Resident trainees, COVID rehab, Home rehab, Obesity and Arthrosis.

OFICIAL SCIENTIFIC JOURNAL

Rehabilitación (Madr) is the official scientific journal of SERMEF. It is a 67 years old journal, published only in Spanish language (abstracts in English). It is currently indexed (since 2019) in MEDLINE, CINAHL, and IME (The Spanish Medical Index). Since 2022 it has an IF of 0,431. Its current rejection index is of a 64%. The journal represents the most important reference for articles published in Spanish language

CONGRESSES

There is an annual National Congress with a high scientific level. The last one took place in Santander on May 2023 with a participation of 953 in a hybrid format. There has been a notable increase in participants in successive editions.

On the other hand, the regional and monographic societies also organize conferences and courses once or twice a year.

TEACHING AND TRAINING

SERMEF organizes two courses a year, taught by the National Society itself

ECOSERMEF

EXPERT DEGREE IN ULTRASOUND FOR REHABILITATION SPECIALISTS. The training program is carried out in collaboration with CEU University. There is a great international participation. Two annual modules with a face-to-face part and an online part.

Extension of teaching hours, accredited with 20 ECTS and 501 hours. The Course language is Spanish.

An extension to 60 ECTS credits (1,500 hours) of this course is now in project for the next future,

in order to obtain a MASTER degree. With the following parts:

Craniocervicofacial, children, lymphedema, econeurography, eco-guided interventionism, hemophilic arthropathy, musculo-skeletal pain, pelvic floor

OSEOSERMEF

It is an online course with three independent courses, based on skeletal pathologies.

COURSE 1: Basic Training in Mineral Metabolism

COURSE 2: Training in Comprehensive Treatment of Osteoporosis

COURSE 3: Training in the management of Osteoporosis, Clinical Management of the patient.

On the other hand, among the courses organized by the subsidiary societies, we must highlight the **Master's Degree in Manual Medicine**, organized by SEMOOYM (The Spanish Society of Orthopedic, Osteopathic and Manual Medicine), together with the University of Valencia. Its teaching program is approved by The FIMM (La Fédération Internationale de Médecine Manuelle)

SERMEF INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS

Periodic meetings have been held with Latin American societies of physical medicine and rehabilitation, as well as with the Portuguese Rehabilitation Society (SPMFR). On the other hand, SERMEF's participation in the last ESPRM/ISPRTM/SPMR congress in Lisbon in 2022 was very active.

From the planned annual activities (Annual Congress; Scientific meetings (3 times a year); Continuous medical education; Certification procedures; Collaboration with the Serbian Medical Camber; Collaboration with health services for design of health organization) in that period, we organized:

The 22nd International Congress of the FRM of Serbia (by the decision of the Health Council of Serbia) was held in Vrnjačka Banja from September 29 to October 2, 2022 under the title: "Physical and Rehabilitation Medicine and new Challenges". Our congresses, which are held every year, traditionally gather PRM specialists from Serbia and neighboring countries (BiH, SR&BIH, MKD, MNE...). This year there were about 390 participants, 34 lecturers by invitation. All papers that passed the review of the Scientific Committee of the Congress and the Editorial Board of the journal (93 papers) were prepared for publication in their entirety in the journal "Balneoclimatologia", which is ranked by the Ministry of Education, Science and Technological Development of the Republic of Serbia.

On October 12, 2022, SAPRM organized the Symposium "70 years of the Rehabilitation Clinic Dr. Miroslav Zotović in Belgrade", where papers from clinical studies and projects were presented. Researchers from the Clinic actively participate in projects of the Ministry of Science of the Republic of Serbia and international projects (Functional electrical therapy (FET) for shaping motor patterns after cerebrovascular stroke, Non-invasive cortical modulation, Hybrid computer interface of the brain to control sensory-motor connection in rehabilitation after stroke (HYBIS), HUTON Tempus project Mechatronics in rehabilitation, COSTS Pain in dementia, DIH HERO HORIZON 2020).

On May 26, 2023, SAPRM organized the Symposium "Multidisciplinary aspects of the treatment of anterior cruciate ligament injury of the knee" under the leadership of prof. Dr. Emilija

Dubljanin Raspopović in Belgrade. By decision of the Health Council of Serbia, the Symposium was accredited as a National Symposium. It gathered around 180 participants from Serbia and surrounding countries.

SAPRM successfully organized the European Board Exam 2023 - UEMS PRM Board Examination - May 26, 2023 in Belgrade.

SAPRM organizes twice a year a Postgraduate Course: "Electrodiagnostic Methods in Physical Medicine And Rehabilitation - Basic level and Advanced level" under the leadership of Ass. prof. Dejan Nikolić. The course was organized at the Institute for Rehabilitation in Belgrade and the University Children's Clinic in Belgrade.

SAPRM members actively participated in the work of international congresses in 2023 with papers: ESCEO congress in Barcelona, Congress of physiatrists of Montenegro, 17th ISPRM World Congress - ISPRM 2023, Cartagena, Colombia, and 15th Mediterranean Congress of PRM, Rome, Italy.

SAPRM is currently organizing the 23rd Congress of PRM of Serbia, which will be held in Zlatibor from 21-24. September 2023 under the title: "New perspectives in the development of physical and rehabilitation medicine". By decision of the Health Council of Serbia, the Congress was accredited as an International Congress.

On October 1, 2022, at the General Assembly of the Association, SAPRM adopted a **new STATUTE of the Serbian Association of Physical and Rehabilitation Medicine,** which harmonized it with the ESPRM Statute. According to the new Statute, a new leadership of the Association and new representatives of SAPRM in ESPRM (which we have already sent you) were elected.

Short report (up to 200 words) on national PRM congress (if organized from September 2022)

TSPRM Specialists organizes National Congress every 2 years. The 8th Medical Rehabilitation Congress, organised by the TSPRM Specialists took place on 9-13 November 2022, at JW Marriott Hotel, Ankara. The first 2 days were allocated for courses at 4 halls. A total of 23 half/full day courses were held. Then, the last 3 days were allocated to plenary lectures, scientific panels, meet-the expert sessions, oral presentations, poster sessions, and satellite symposiums. The content of the Congress included almost all practice/interest areas of PRM including neurological, paediatric, cardiopulmonary and musculoskeletal rehabilitation. The number of participants was 760.

TSPRM organizes National Congress every 2 years and a Course Congress every other year. The 4th PMR Course Days Congress, organized by the TSPMR took place on 16-19 March 2023 in Antalya with the participation of 643 attendees. The program included 36 half-day courses and 6 oral presentation sessions. Each course was presented twice by expert professors on that field. Examples of courses were amputee rehabilitation and prosthesis prescription, upper extremity orthoses prescription, lower extremity orthoses prescription, diagnostic USG for the knee joint, upper extremity lymphedema rehabilitation, lower extremity lymphedema rehabilitation, pedobarographic evaluation, botulinum toxin injections in upper and lower extremities, etc.

Another Course Congress on a special field "Interventional PRM and local painful conditions" was organized by the TSPRM Specialists on 19-21 May 2023 in Bodrum with the participation of 310 attendees. The course/congress program included mainly musculoskeletal ultrasonographic interventions as well as other interventional treatments such as botulinum toxin injections, transcranial magnetic stimulation, radiofrequency applications, spinal injections and nerve blocks.
